## Brief Job Descriptions

All other volunteer opportunities for this festival are for 18+

<b>Admin/Info</b>	Area Leaders communication area, distribute radios, provide information to Leaders, data entry, handle <i>Lost and Found</i> , interact with patrons and answer queries.
<b>Backstage</b>	(Private recruiting)
<b>Beer Tent</b>	Bartending. Open, mix and pour drinks in a fast paced environment, while ensuring the responsible service of alcohol, and complying with the festival's regulations. A lot of standing.
<b>Box Office</b>	Processing ticket orders, selling day tickets, putting appropriate wristbands on patrons.
<b>Cash &amp; ID</b>	Diligently check ID and assess levels of intoxication. Ability to accurately process financial transactions. Deliver information in a friendly manner (i.e.: refusing service to patrons who are showing signs of intoxication, etc.)
<b>Floaters</b>	Assigned to support all other areas of the festival that may be short-handed. A great way to test out a variety of areas!
<b>Gates</b>	Greet patrons and check ticket or wristband for access. Answer patron queries and direct them where to go. This position is standing only.
<b>Green Team</b>	Come support our greening initiatives with this essential team! Emptying, sorting, and collecting of recycling and compost materials. Some heavy lifting, a lot of standing and walking.
<b>Inventory Control</b>	(Private recruiting)
<b>Servers &amp; Hawkers</b>	Under the direction of the Cash & ID leadership team (and same shift times), servers and hawkers are required to provide the responsible service of alcohol to patrons while complying with the festival's regulations. Checking ID and assessing levels of intoxication.
<b>Sponsor Tent</b>	The various positions include Wait staff and Host duties, bartending and serving, while ensuring the responsible service of alcohol, and complying with festival's regulations.
<b>VIP</b>	Greet and ensure patrons' proper accreditation, host, bartender and serving, while ensuring the responsible service of alcohol, and complying with festival's regulations.
<b>Volunteer Check In</b>	Requires great attention to details. Greet volunteers, check ID, check in all volunteers, hand out t-shirts, food vouchers, etc.
<b>Volunteer Chill Zone</b>	Come help create a Chill Zone where volunteers can come and enjoy games, light snacks, etc., before, during and after their shift. Duties include: Setting-up and handing out snacks and beverages, assist with games, clean up of area, maintain clean & safe work environment.
